At that time, उपयातस्य भवनं भवस्य towards Paramasiva who is coming to your palace; प्रसभं with haste; अभ्युत्थाने when you get up and go to welcome Him, परिजन उक्तिः विजयते the concerned words of Your attendants, एतेषु प्रणम्रेषु when Brahma and others are prostrating to you, are heard thus, “परिहर Avoid the किरीटं वैरिञ्चं पुरः crown of Brahma in front; स्खलसि You may trip कैटभभिदः कठोरे कोटीरे on the heavy crown of Vishnu who killed Kaitabhaasura; जहि Move off जंभारि-मकुटम् the crown of Indra”
